

# Miners Belt Lower Body Harness - MBLH



The new Australian Standard (AS/NZS 1891.1 : 2007) was released in July 2007. One of the principal changes from the previous edition of this Standard is the use of belts alone is no longer specified for any purpose. The standard specifies only full-body or lower-body harnesses for potential fall purposes. This means that a lower-body harness is the minimum requirement under the Standard. (600mm) max.

The new Miners Belt Lower-Body Harness has the ability to tuck the leg straps into a small pouch which retained on the back of harness. As with the Miners Belt, the chest strap is still able to be attached if required.

Saferight has also incorporated a double action quick release buckle into the main belt of the Miners Belt Lower-Body Harness. This provides the user with ease to get in and out of the harness quickly and safely.
