Overview

This course will enable participants who are required to supervise and issue hot work permits according to BHP Billiton Iron Ore Hot Work Procedure TRN-IHS-SAF-133.

PRE-REQUISITE:

1. Successful completion of BHPBIO Perform Hot Work L2 to receive a Statement of Attainment to MSAPMPER300B—Issue Work Permits (Hot Work/Confined Space).

Key Outcomes

Key areas covered include:

- Reviewing the conditions under which the work will be undertaken.
- Examining the site to determine the hazards and safety requirements.
- Ensuring the appropriate permit is selected depending on workplace procedures.
- Determining the appropriate conditions for the permit.
- Raising, authorising and issuing the necessary permit.
- Monitoring compliance with permit conditions.
- Reporting any indiscretions or violations of permit conditions.
- Managing the permit process, e.g. extensions
- Signing off work permits on completion of work.
