PRE-REQUISITE

1. Successful completion of BHPBIO Working at Heights – General Worker – RIIOHS204A.

At the completion of this course participants will be able to identify legislative and/or site requirements for working at height, understand and evaluate risk assessments for working at height, correctly document and control a working at height permit and understand and apply common working at heights controls, e.g. harnesses, scaffold, etc, according to BHP Billiton Iron Ore Working at Heights—Supervisor Procedure TRN-IHS-SAF-153.
